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The pitching eligibility regulation is covered under Regulation VI (per the 2023 Rulebook).

League age 11-12 is 85 pitches per day. League age 9-10 is 75 pitches per day. League age 6-8 is 50 pitches per day.

Note 1: A pitcher's count for the purposes of day(s) rest threshold is determined by the first pitch thrown to the batter.

Note 2: A pitcher who delivers 41 or more pitches in a game (and is not covered under the threshold exception) cannot play the position of catcher for the remainder of that day.

Note 3: Any player, who has played the position of catcher in four (4) or more innings in a game, is not eligible to pitch on that calendar day.

Per Regulation VI(d) Note: Under no circumstances shall a player pitch in three (3) consecutive days. Pitchers age 14 and under must adhere to the following rest requirements. If a player pitches 66 or more pitches in a day, four (4) calendar days of rest must be observed. If a player pitches in a day, two (2) calendar days of rest must be observed. If a player pitches 21 - 35 pitches in a day, one (1) calendar day of rest must be observed. If a player pitches in a day, no (0) calendar day of rest is required. A player may not pitch in more than one game in a day.
